DARWIN YOUTH CHOIR

The Darwin Youth and Children's Choir (DYCC) was formed in 1994 under the directorship of Mrs. Emma Tantengco. It developed to a choir of about 23 "kids" from ages 7 to 18.

At the end of 2005, Mrs. Tantengco retired to Perth and the choir went into a short recess before it reconvened as the *Territory Proud Youth Choir* which then auditioned for the ABC Classic FM Choir of the year competition in 2006. The choir was successful in reaching the final of the SA/NT group and was placed second after a great performance in the final at the Adelaide Town Hall.

After this competition, the choir lost some of its seniors to year 12 and Tertiary studies interstate, but kept an experienced core. It auditioned for new members and reformed as the Darwin Youth Choir in early 2007 under the direction of Emma Gavican.

The choir now has a talented group of around 12 kids, aged 9 – 18 the core of whom has been together for 5 years, and who love to sing and tour....!

The choir's excursions interstate and overseas have included:

- 2003 Sing Out Festival in Narrogin, WA
- 2004 National Choralifest in Adelaide
- 2005 Commonwealth Games Torch Relay Ceremony in Brunei
- 2005 Sing Out Festival in Bunbury, WA
- 2006 ABC Classic FM final in Adelaide.

In preparation for the Jerusalem Passion, the choir has been under the directorship of Nora Lewis.
